### Purpose

Upon completion of this class, participants will be able to manage cardiorespiratory emergencies by using the systematic ACLS guidelines of the American Heart Association (AHA). This includes how to evaluate and manage a sudden adult respiratory arrest, VF/VT arrest, asystole, pulseless electrical activity, bradycardias, stable and unstable tachycardias, acute coronary syndromes and acute stroke.

### Contact Hour Information

Participants will earn 8 contact hours for the Initial Course and 4 contact hours for the Renewal Course.

This continuing education activity is approved by the American Heart Association, a CSCBEMS accredited organization. CECBEMS Provider Number: AMHA0013.

### Objectives

Following the program, the participant will be able to:

- Recognize and initiate early management of pre-arrest conditions that may result in cardiac arrest or complicate resuscitation outcome.
- Demonstrate proficiency in providing BLS care, including chest compressions and integration of AED use.
- Manage cardiac arrest until return of spontaneous circulation, termination of resuscitation or transfer of care.
- Identify and treat ischemic chest pain and expedite the care of patients with acute coronary syndromes.
- Recognize other life-threatening clinical situations and provide effective initial care and transfer to reduce disability and death.
- Demonstrate effective communication as a member/lead of a resuscitation team and recognize the impact of team-dynamics on overall team performance.

### Target Audience

The ACLS Course is designed for healthcare providers who either direct or participate in the management of cardiopulmonary arrest or other cardiovascular emergencies. This includes personnel in emergency response, emergency medicine, intensive care, and critical care units such as physicians, nurses, and paramedics, as well as others who need an ACLS course completion card for job or other requirements.

# Course Specific Objectives

## Initial Course:

Through didactic instruction and active participation in simulated cases, the student will enhance their skills in the recognition and intervention of cardiopulmonary arrest, immediate post arrest, acute dysrhythmia, stroke, and acute coronary syndromes.

The following knowledge and skills are REQUIRED for successful completion of the initial course:

- AHA BLS Provider skills
- Working knowledge of EKG rhythms
- Basic ACLS drug and pharmacology knowledge
- Practical application of ACLS rhythms & drugs

## Renewal Course:

The renewal course is designed for individuals who have taken the ACLS Initial course previously and incorporate ACLS algorithms and ideology in their everyday work practice. Those who do not work in environments with daily use of ACLS algorithms are encouraged to take the initial course as a refresher. Course participants must have excellent working knowledge of EKG rhythms and ACLS pharmacology.

# Locations

## Windfeldt Room, CentraCare Plaza
