

Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) 2024 Initial & Renewal Course Schedule

Purpose

Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) is a classroom-based, instructor-led course that uses a series of simulated pediatric emergencies to reinforce the important concepts of a systematic approach to pediatric assessment, basic life support, PALS treatment algorithms, effective resuscitation, and team dynamics. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive a PALS Provider Course Completion eCard, which is valid for two years.

Objectives

Following the program, the participant will be able to:

- Describe the timely recognition and interventions required to prevent respiratory and cardiac arrest in any pediatric patient.
- Describe the systematic approach to pediatric evaluation by using the initial impression, primary and secondary assessments, and diagnostic tests.
- · Describe priorities and specific interventions for infants and children with respiratory and/or circulatory emergencies.
- · Explain the importance of effective team dynamics during pediatric resuscitation.
- Describe the key elements of post-resuscitation management.
- · Perform hi-quality CPR.
- · Perform effective respiratory management within the scope of practice.
- Select and administer appropriate medications and electrical therapies when presented with arrhythmia scenario.
- Establish rapid vascular access to administer fluid medication.
- Demonstrate effective communication and team dynamics both as a team member and as a team leader.
