CentraCare Laboratory Services expands to Albany

CentraCare Clinic – Albany opened Jan. 4 in the building previously occupied by Albany Medical Center, continuing the tradition of caring for patients in the community. With the change, CentraCare Health Laboratory Services also expanded to provide services for patients in Albany.

The laboratory, now CentraCare Laboratory Services – Albany (CCLS – Albany), has two medical technologists and three medical laboratory technicians. This team provides services for the family practice clinic, urgent care, Mother of Mercy nursing home and Home Health. The staff also has been cross training at the Health Plaza, Paynesville and Melrose laboratories.

The CCLS – Albany laboratory performs basic chemistry, complete blood counts, coagulation and urinalysis. They also complete manual differentials, sedimentation rates and rapid kit testing. The location is a collection site for employment DOT and non-DOT drug screens and breath alcohol testing for area businesses. Testing that is not performed on site is sent to CCLS at St. Cloud Hospital.

The CCLS – Albany laboratory team takes great pride in taking part in their community's well-being by participating in health fairs for area businesses and schools. The CCLS – Albany team enjoys the benefit of being in a smaller community so they can get to know their patients

Long Prairie native returns home to manage laboratory services


