As part of the Epic Beaker go-live, <u>on November 3rd</u>, the following changes to CCLS performed testing and testing availability will be made.

- Reporting units for CRP, High Sensitivity (LAB0208041) will be updated from mg/dL to mg/L to match CDC recommendations. The units for the CRP, non-sensitive assay (LAB02049805) will continue to be reported in mg/dL.
- 2. Estimated Glomerular Filtration Rate (eGFR) calculations will update from the MDRD equation to the CKD-EPI equation to better accommodate high eGFR results.
- 3. Rh Factor, (LAB0208447) will be <u>discontinued</u>. Please order a full ABO/Rh Blood Type when medically necessary.
- 4. Lamellar Bodies (LAB0291039) will be <u>discontinued</u> in-house.
- 5. Clinitest (LAB0205807) will be <u>discontinued</u>, as the product is no longer available from the manufacturer.
