As part of the Epic Beaker go-live, on November 3rd, the following changes to CCLS performed testing and testing availability will be made.

1. Reporting units for CRP, High Sensitivity (LAB0208041) will be updated from mg/dL to **mg/L** to match CDC recommendations. The units for the CRP, non-sensitive assay (LAB02049805) will continue to be reported in mg/dL.
2. Estimated Glomerular Filtration Rate (eGFR) calculations will update from the MDRD equation to the CKD-EPI equation to better accommodate high eGFR results.
3. Rh Factor, (LAB0208447) will be discontinued. Please order a full ABO/Rh Blood Type when medically necessary.
4. Lamellar Bodies (LAB0291039) will be discontinued in-house.
5. Clinitest (LAB0205807) will be discontinued, as the product is no longer available from the manufacturer.
